

Printing Nitoku pages is no different from printing any other web page, you can print them using the printing functionality of your browser. Nevertheless, we have made a couple of printing design decisions that we believe will provide our users with a better printing experience.

First; when you print a page, the sidebar will not be printed as part of the page, therefore if you close any dialog that may be open, the page that you print will be a clean page. "clean" in the sense that it will not include any interface buttons. You could see an example of how this page is printed here: printing.pdf



1 Note that to avoid printing the frame of the window you should display the page as a web page. If the page that you want to print has a page frame, click on the "Open as web page" icon. The web page will not have a frame and you should be able to print it without any user interface details included on the printed page.

Second; Adding a header with one hashtag will add a page-break to the printed document, e.g.:

Please note that the first hashtag is assumed that is the page title of the first page, therefore the first hashtag on the document will not add a page break.
